ITDA Dive Leadership International Certification 3 levels

The primary objective for the ITDA Dive Leadership Course Program is to train, educate and assess practical diving skills to professional levels to produce self-confident well educated and competent leaders who can supervise dives, lead dives & certify as ITDA specialist professionals / Entry level Scuba Instructors.

Resources / Equipment Required (You should have your own!)

- Mask (Scuba), Snorkel and Fins, Open heel, or Full Foot
- Scuba Unit Cylinder, Regulator Set (with Alternate Air Source and SPG)
- Suitable Environmental Protection Wet Suit/Dry Suit or other
- Weights and weight belt or integrated BCD system
- BCD / Buoyancy Control Device or Stab Jacket

- Torch / Light (to bring colours to life!)
- Cutting Tool / Deco Buoy (Inflatable)
- Pocket Mask for CPR
- UW Camera/Video (For last 2 dives to enjoy the experience)

ITDA Dive leaders are unique in the dive industry as a leadership level that are trained and certified to be dive professionals, both as working divers and as diving educators at entry level and specialist instructor levels. ITDA Dive Leaders may take module programs for additional certification levels in:

- Occupational Diving Diving Operations Supervisor Working Diver Specialist
- Diving Educator Assistant Instructor / Dive Guide / Entry Specialist Instructor (IHMP Instructor)
- Direct Upgrade level to ITDA Open Water Instructor or Advanced / Specialist Instructor

International Certification Standards (Dives maybe added for Additional Specialist Levels)

Competencies of an ITDA dive leader from ITDA standards as a consummate diving professional.

An ITDA Dive Leader at this level shall be trained to have sufficient knowledge, skills, and experience to lead / guide divers without instructor supervision and to train and supervise, certify, or co-certify as a specialist instructor to ISO 24802 /Diving Educator – Instructor Entry Level. (May train & certify divers as supervised)

International Certification Standards (ITDA Dive Leader minimum) Includes:

Demonstrate competencies and Theory / Skills / Specialist Certifications (x6 Specialist Diver Certification Levels)

- 1. Buoyancy & Gas Management
- 2. Decompression Diver to 40m/132ft.
- 3. Advanced Open Water Nitrox (To 40% Oxygen with decompression at stops ("Air" is Travel Mix))
- 4. Computer Diving & Advanced Dive Planning Emergency Planning for Deco Diving
- 5. Navigation and Limited Visibility
- 6. Diving First Aid (ITDA-IHMP Certification) To Include Oxygen First Aid & AED.

Restrictions (International ITDA Leadership Certifications)

- Depth Limit of 40m/132ft. (Unless Deep Diver / Deco Specialist) Module is taken & passed.
- Depth Limitations for Deco / Specialist is to certified level. i.e., Deep Air to Max 50m/165ft. etc.
- May train introduction to scuba / day courses ONLY under direct Open Water instructor supervision
- May NOT supervise or train divers in "Overhead Environments" Unless certified & qualified!
- May NOT train or Certify "ITDA Open Water Diver" but may supervise training / class, under supervision.
