Time / Skills Requirement

For the Scuba Introduction program, a minimum of 3-4 hours is required.

- For the Day Course 6 Hours Minimum is required. (For Certification)
- Snorkel Basic Scuba Skills: Regulator / Mask / Swimming and Buoyancy

## Skills Training / Drills

After the above skills are completed, students may move to deeper water 3m./9ft. - Max 6m./18ft.

Repeat Regulator and Mask Skills, Drills Adjusting Buoyancy for depth.

Instructor / Supervisor will control initial buoyancy with BCD adjustments

When students are comfortable. A short Experience Dive will follow to enjoy the new marine world.

Ascend following reef, sand bank or in pool from deep to shallow / Inflate BCD on surface / exit

## **Critical Care Procedures / Supervision**

Dive Students must be closely observed to ensure maximum comfort and safety and assisted as required with skills. A Dive Leader maybe used as a certified assistant and skills demonstrations / Supervisor but only under the direct in-water supervision of an Instructor (Certified any agency) ... ITDA Dive Leaders may take our Leadership Upgrade to Entry Level Instructor.

Risks Include: Choking on water / Aspiration of Water, Breath Holding, Rapid Ascent with breath holding / Marine Life Injuries / Lost Diver / Stress / Not paying attention to instructor or staff...

The instructor / leader may certify with ITDA HQ or direct the student(s) to the ITDA Website to register their certification, the E-Cert is free / included if the workbook is purchased, e-certificate is included with materials cost.
